Large-scale transformations caused by dramatic changes in geopolitics, unprecedented globalization, and the accelerated digitalization are the characteristics of today's stage of the global economic development. In such a complex geopolitical and economic environment, we are increasingly running the risks of the lasting globally destructive financial crises, new trade war threats, unfair play between partners, an unfair competition, and an increased use of the less developed countries' resources by stronger countries. Therefore, building an equal partnership between friendly countries seems to be a timely and quite relevant task. Russia and Vietnam are the countries that face similar issues, have similar social and economic conditions, identical prioritized goals and objectives, values, and mentality. The conference goal is to find a strategic prospect for cooperation between Russia and Vietnam, new formats and mechanisms of interaction based on the principles of equality, reliable guarantees, and build mutual trust with a view to ensure sustainable social and economic development of the two countries in today's unstable environment.

Authors from NEU are requested to submit their draft papers in English of approximately 7000 words via email conference@neu.edu.vn no later than August 22, 2025.

All papers must be original or review work that has neither been published nor currently under review by any journal, conference, or outlet.

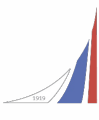
Travel Arrangement

- Banking system transformation: trends and counter-trends
- Russian and Vietnamese financial markets: internal and external restrictions hampering development
- Investment banking development issues

- Trade and economic cooperation between Russia and Vietnam
- Energy security of Russia and Vietnam
- Achieving global development goals and the modern world economic system transformation

Economics and Business

- New challenges and new solutions: Russian companies' approaches to changes in the external environment
- Examination of the Russian companies' financial stability indicators in the changing macroeconomic environment
- Strategies used by the Russian companies in adapting to changes in the business environment
- How can Russia and Vietnam use their competitive advantages in the high-tech sector for building integrated supply chains that would absorb the geopolitical shocks?
- How are investment risks managed, given the geopolitical environment?
